This is a follow up volume to the authors previous Women Astronauts, that reflects the careers of women involved in space exploration who are not necessary astronauts. A selection of biographies, interviews and personal comments from women in a wide variety of 'space careers' including flying, medicine, SETI research, astronomy, art, media, management and engineering are presented.

The work includes a brief history of women 'in space', offers career guidance and supplementary information and closes with the authors personal memory of meeting STS-107 astronaut Kalpana 'KC' Chawla.
